

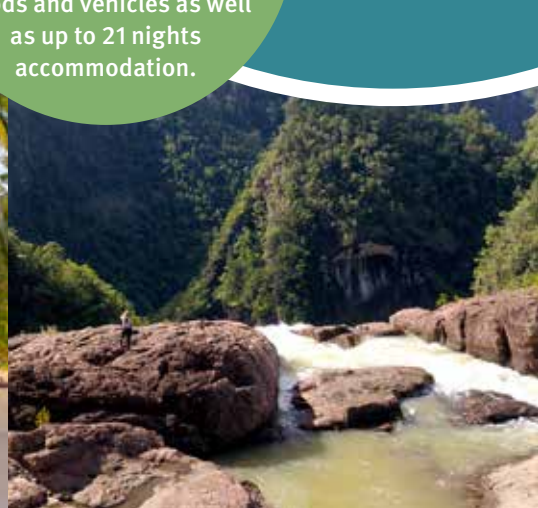
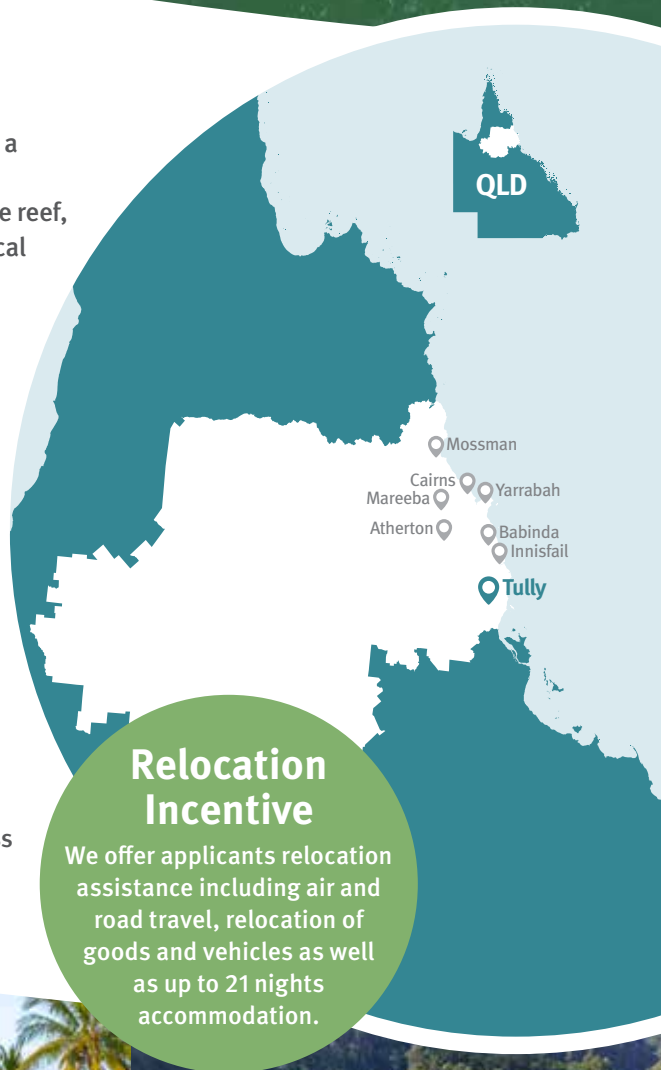

Tully Where rainforest meets reef

Tully is a small town roughly midway between Cairns and Townsville. Being a working country town with primarily banana and sugar cane farms, it has a welcoming multicultural community. Nestled between the rainforest and the reef, Tully offers a relaxed outdoor lifestyle in a beautiful green environment. Local attractions include the tourism precinct of Mission Beach with its selection of restaurants and cafés. All-weather boat ramps provide access to the World Heritage listed Great Barrier Reef and local river estuaries. Beautiful waterfalls adorn the region, swimming holes like Alligators Nest, which is a picturesque picnic area with cool freshwater and only 10 minutes' drive from Tully. From bush walking and white-water rafting to sky diving, reef fishing and scuba diving, there is something for everyone.

About Tully Hospital

Tully Hospital is a 20-bed facility that provides 24x7 Emergency Care, ward-based care (including palliative care), and Primary Care services. Supported by clinicians that provide Community Health, Oral Health, and Community Mental Health, Tully Hospital services a population of 12,000 ranging from El Arish to Bilyana, including the coast towns of Mission Beach, Wongaling Beach, Bingle Bay and Tully Heads. Visiting clinicians (including physicians, paediatricians and well women's nurse) further enhance the access to care for the community. Under the COAG s19(2) Exemptions Initiative, Tully Hospital plays an active role in providing access to Primary Care services.

Medical Career opportunities

SMO – Our SMOs are experienced GPs (ACRRM/RACGP) with advanced skills in Emergency Medicine. We take pride not only in our clinical work across the spectrum of acute and chronic care, but also enjoy supporting, teaching, and mentoring our junior doctors and medical students.

PHO – Our PHOs rotate from Cairns, Townsville, or Brisbane, and often step up in their roles to be practicing more independently. This is particularly true on solo-shifts, being the only doctor looking after the entire hospital (including ED). Our junior doctors remain well supported by our SMOs and nurses alike.

RMO – Our RMOs get a taste of what it is like to have a career as a rural generalist. They are rostered predominantly to Primary Care work (including our outreach clinic to the Indigenous settlement of Jumbun) with a good mix of ED and ward rounds too.
