Yarrabah is an Aboriginal Community originally inhabited by the Gunggandji people but has other peoples brought to Yarrabah as part of the Stolen Generation. It's a picturesque 45-minute drive from Cairns, with a population of 3,000 residents.

About Yarrabah Emergency Services

Queensland Health's Yarrabah Emergency Service provides 24hr Emergency Service to the township and catchment area of Yarrabah with 3.2FTE Senior Medical Officers. Health Services for the community of Yarrabah are consolidated under one roof, incorporating the Queensland Health Yarrabah Emergency Service, Queensland Ambulance Service, Satellite Renal Dialysis, Mental Health, Women's Health, Child Health and Gurriny Yealamucka Primary Health Care Centre.



Relocation Incentive
